

**CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT (SECTION 30) CANON 2010
ASSENTING ORDINANCE 2011.**

ORDINANCE NO 13 OF 2011

AN ORDINANCE

To assent to the "Constitution Amendment (Section 30) Canon 2010" being a General Synod Canon.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Constitution Amendment (Section 30) Canon 2010 of the General Synod of the Anglican Church of Australia should be assented to by the Diocese of Grafton.

THEREFORE the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton in Synod assembled decree and enact as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Constitution Amendment (Section 30) Canon 2010 Assenting Ordinance 2011.

ADOPTION

2. The constitution Amendment (Section 30) Canon 2010 as set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby assented to.

DATE OF COMMENCEMENT

3. This Ordinance shall come into effect on the date that the Bishop assents to this Ordinance.

CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT (SECTION 30) CANON 2010

The General Synod prescribes as follows:-

Title

1. This Canon may be cited as the "Constitution Amendment (Section 30) Canon, 2010"

Amendment to Section 30 of the Constitution


2. Section 30 of the Constitution is amended by adding immediately after the word "thereafter" in proviso (c) the words 'of its opinion and its reasons therefor'.
3. Section 30 of the Constitution is further amended by adding immediately after the word 'opinion' where first occurring in proviso (c)(ii) the words 'as aforesaid'
