J° 1 of 2000 THE PORT MACQUARIE ANGLICAN SCHOOL INCORPORATION ORDINANCE 2000

AN ORDINANCE to authorise the incorporation of the Port Macquarie Anglican School Council constituted by the Port Macquarie Anglican School Constitution Ordinance 2000 as a Body Corporate.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS a Council has been constituted for The Port Macquarie Anglican School under the provisions of the Port Macquarie Anglican School Constitution Ordinance 2000.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the said Council should be incorporated under the provisions of the Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938;

AND WHEREAS by the provisions of the said Act and the Bodies Corporate (Delegation of Powers) Ordinance 1988 the Bishop-in-Council is empowered during the recess of Synod to exercise certain powers and such recess now exists;

THEREFORE the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of such powers and in the name of the Synod hereby ordains declares directs and rules as follows:

CONSTITUTION AS BODY CORPORATE

1. It is expedient for the purpose of managing, governing and controlling the said Port Macquarie Anglican School that the persons who are from time to time the members of the Port Macquarie Anglican School Council should be constituted as a Body Corporate under the name of the Port Macquarie Anglican School Council.

SHORT TITLE

- 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port Macquarie Anglican School Incorporation Ordinance 2000.
- This Ordinance shall come into effect upon receiving the assent of the Bishop.
