

**THE PARISH OF CASINO WYAN LAND SALE ORDINANCE 2006**  
**Ordinance No 8 of 2006.**

An Ordinance to provide for the sale of certain vacant lands at Wyan, ~~Brunner Highway~~ <sup>71st</sup> in the Parish of Casino.

**Preamble**

**WHEREAS** the lands described in the Schedule hereto are vested in The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton.

**THEREFORE** the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Grafton decree and enact as follows:

**Opinion**

1. It has become, due to the removal of the church building at Wyan to Leeville, expedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of any trusts relating to the vacant lands described in the schedule hereto to sell the same.

**Powers to Sell**

2. The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the same by public auction or private contract for such sum or sums of money and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by The Corporate Trustees.
3. The Corporate Trustees are hereby authorised to execute and do all necessary deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things for giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
4. The money arising out of such sale shall be paid to The Corporate Trustees and, after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating hereto and twenty five per centum of such net proceeds being placed in the Ministry Development Fund, shall be held in trust for the general use and purposes of the Parish of Casino.

**Short Title**

This Ordinance may be cited as The Parish of Casino Wyan Land Sale Ordinance 2006.

**Schedule**

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land being Portion 64, Parish of Hogarth, County of Richmond containing 2,023.5m<sup>2</sup> and being the whole of the land referred to in Certificate of Title Volume 1253, Folio 72.
